

■ Regional Revitalization Initiatives

- Support the development, maintenance and operation of private networks for a variety of purposes, including medicine, academia, logistics, disaster prevention and others
 - In addition to providing fiber optic access, we will develop and provide the best mix for each purpose, including local 5G (Sub6 license application pending), LPWA and Wi-Fi
- → Aim to develop Smart Cities by connecting and expanding each private network through a high-volume transmission infrastructure
- Establish a regional edge in each region that is multi-access-compatible and allows for easy utilization of a variety of functions
 - We plan to launch a "Video AI Analysis Service," which conducts detection and analysis of suspicious activity and traffic flows based on video data, as the first step
- Offering of high-speed, high-volume and high-quality enterprise NW services

 We will launch "Interconnected WAN," which provides fixed rates regardless of distance and area and provides for stable operation by business users
- → Provide easy-to-use proactive operation monitoring and other support menus for carriers and content distributors


■ Support Regional Customers' DX
