

“Sustainable Office Transformation for Future of Work”

The Singapore Office Integration Project transformed ten traditional offices into three modern, collaborative spaces.

By embracing cloud-first technology, we achieved a 30% cost reduction and energy saving over 1 million kWh/year through data center migration to Azure cloud and efficient IT asset management.

We also enhanced meeting spaces, health monitoring, and sustainability, leading to a 76% workplace satisfaction rating.

I believe we work best when we are together.

Jaselle Yeo (Business Analyst): Great minds think together and come up with great ideas.

We went into COVID overnight, into remote work immediately.

Our flagship Apeira office embodies our vision, promoting productivity and collaboration to better serve clients.

We also implemented a zero-trust security model, centralized IT operations, and automation to create a secure and intelligent workplace.

Pascal: The cloud network, and the zero-trust security is helping us to connect our clients, our employees and our partners in a single place. This technology is an enable for the ecosystem to work together and centrally managed.

Siri (Director, Sustainability Management, (Asia Pacific)): By consolidating ten offices into three, we strategically minimized our environmental impact through sustainable practices.
We prioritized furniture reuse and waste reduction.
Our commitment to diversity and inclusion is evident in our office design, which fosters an inclusive and equitable work culture.

"Our new office move delivered substantial cost savings through e-waste disposal, device relocation, and decommissioning.

Additionally, we achieved a 40% monthly opex reduction by consolidating ISDN circuits and shifting calling workloads to Microsoft Teams.

Transitioning legacy servers to the cloud also cut costs by 30%.

Furthermore, our efforts led to a 30% reduction in utility consumption, saving 1,000,000 KWh/year, while aligning with NTT's Zero-to-Landfill policy for responsible IT asset disposal.

Together, we're using technology to create workspaces of the future while achieving our sustainability goals.
