Well generally, if you want to know traffic counts or how many vehicles are driving incorrectly on the street, we generally have to use a human individual to go out to the intersection and monitor it.

Working with NTT DATA, they were able to craft a solution for us. They were able to help us to be able to say, Okay, we want to put these cameras here. Here's the bandwidth requirements. This is some of the things that you want to think about in deploying though,

We have since use that data to install a street light to help warn drivers that it is a one-way street to help curb these incidents.

The data shows that we used to have approximately 40 a day. Now we're seeing on average three or four a week.

We have deployed a Smart solution around the parks of Las Vegas that supports UNSDG target 11.6 for healthy environment and allows all citizens to have equitable access to green spaces as in SDG target 9.1.

We are excited the solution also enables the city personnel to drive to locations to monitor only "as needed", reducing vehicle emissions and making for more efficient and sustainable operations.

We chose to partner with NTT data on the smart Parks initiative, because they brought a lot of value added to the table.

We're able now to use camera and computer vision technologies to monitor those all remotely and allowing the parks to still have the same level of safety and security. But is also providing as a wealth of data we never had.

Las Vegas continues to look to NTT DATA to find ways to advance towards new ways of reducing energy consumption by embracing all the technology of NTT DATA and its partners.

With NTT DATA's support, they have moved to the Microsoft Azure environment which is a big savings in energy usage for the city."
